


# Where is Bologna?



## BOLOGNA IS JUST AROUND THE CORNER

Bologna Airport is an important hub for several European Airlines such as Lufthansa and Ryanair. Bologna is connected to most major European Cities with several daily flights. Bologna Airport (Guglielmo Marconi International Airport) vicinity allows for a mere 15-30 minute taxi or bus ride to the City center and most hotels.

When using high-speed trains (travelling at a speed of up to 250 Km/h), Bologna is only 37 minutes away from Florence, one hour from Milan, and about two hours from Rome and Venice. Frequent train connections permit to easily reach most other major Italian Cities. In addition, many Italian motorways pass by Bologna and allow to easily travel by car to Italian and European destinations.

For its strategic geographic location – at the junction between the south and the north of Italy – and because of abundant and frequent connections, Bologna is the one of the main Italian railway destinations.
