TRANSPORTATION

- **Subway:** The TURRO stop on the Red Line subway is just a two minute walk from the Ramada Plaza.
- **Train:** from Stazione Centrale take Green Line subway, LORETO stop and then take Red Line subway, TURRO stop.
- **Airport - Linate International:** The Ramada Plaza is 8 km from Linate Airport. Take the Line 73, go to SAN BABILA stop and take Red Line Subway, TURRO stop.
- **Airport - Malpensa International:** Malpensa Express train connect the airport to the Central Station. From the Central Station take Green Line subway, LORETO stop and then take Red Line subway, TURRO stop.
- **Motorways:** Take Freeway East towards Venezia/Lecco, exit 10, in the direction of the city centre.
